


Data Analysis of the Table - I

Q-1: Does the TV has positive effect on students' learning? If yes, how?





Q-2: How does watching Television affect students' performance in school?










Q-4: Does the Mass Media (TV) have negative effect on students' learning? If yes, how?




33% Teachers have said that Mass media have negative effect on students' learning and supporting with answer some stupid programmes effect on their study and others said that for students TV watching is waste of time.


Q-6: How does mass media communication (TV) help to shape the students' behavior and influence of their thinking?

Q-7: What according to you is the most powerful mass media?



Q-8: How much time do students watch TV every day?


- \square Two hours a day \square Three hours a day \square Four hours a day

Q-9: What type of television programmes do your students watch the most?


