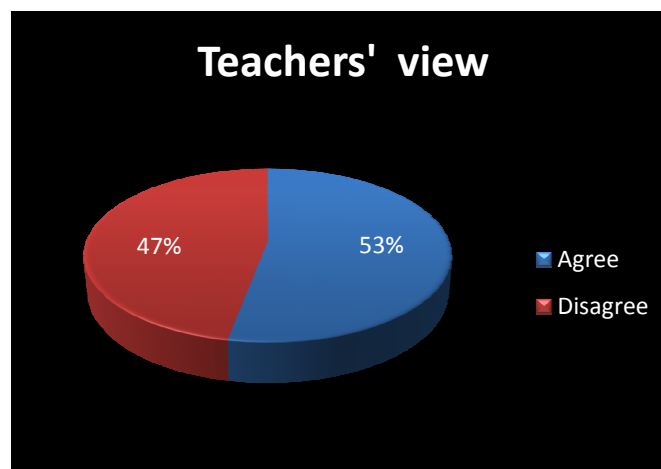

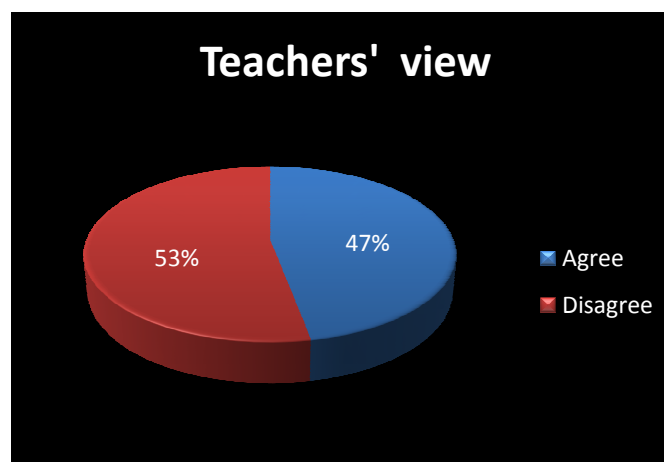

1). watching too much television leads to violence among students.



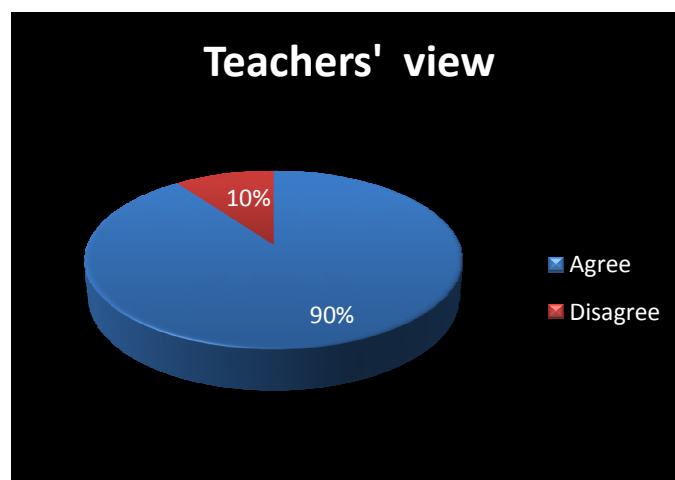
53% Teachers have agree that Watching too much television leads to violence among students where 47% Teachers have disagree that Watching too much television leads to violence among students.

2). Violence on television makes children act violently.



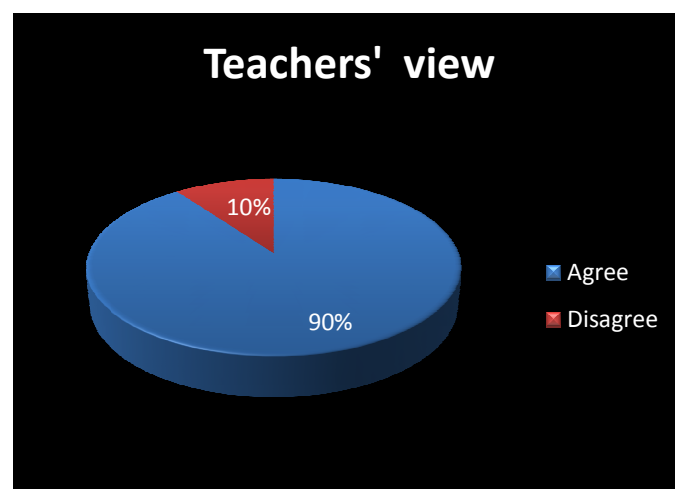

3). TV Programs are helpful in improving the English Language of children.



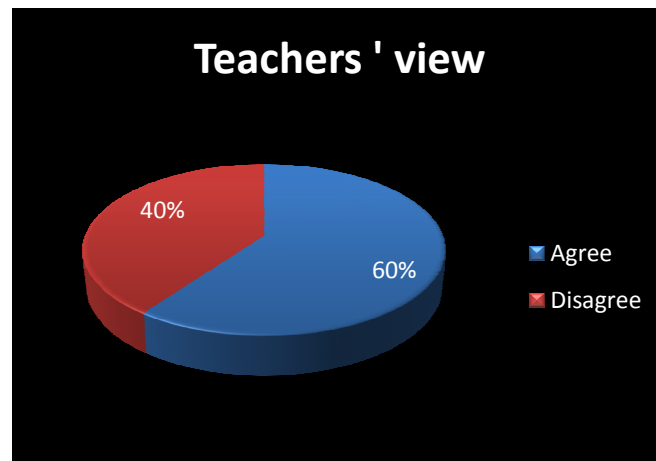

4). TV affects children's brain development.



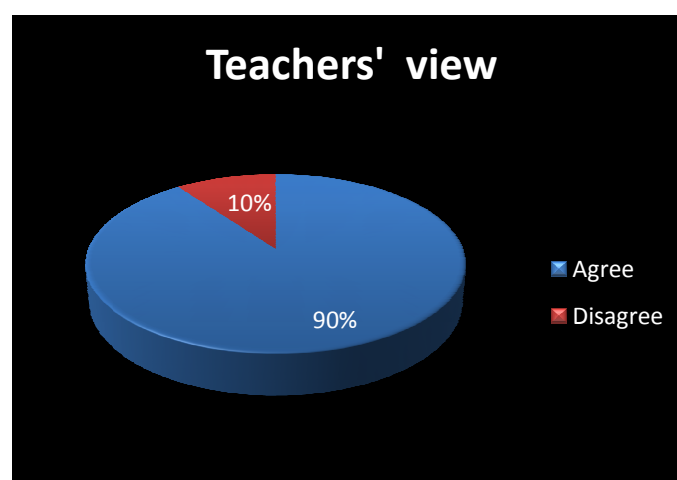

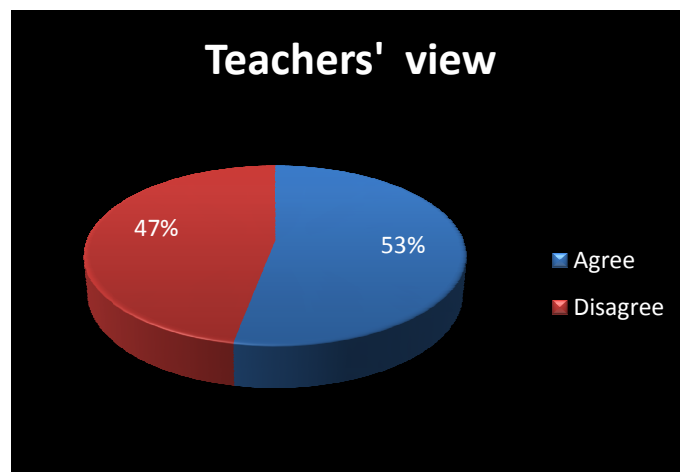

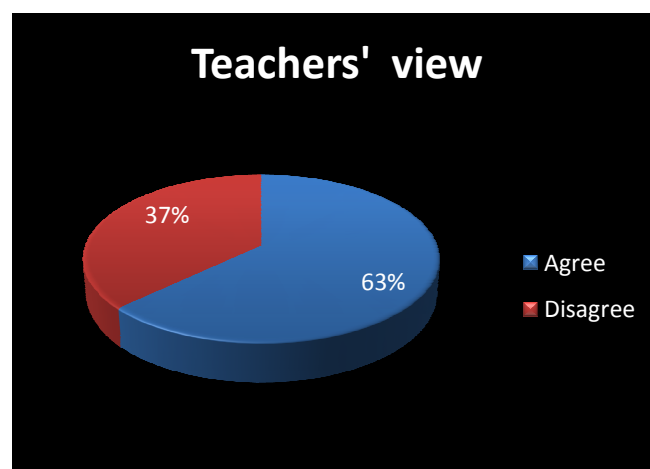

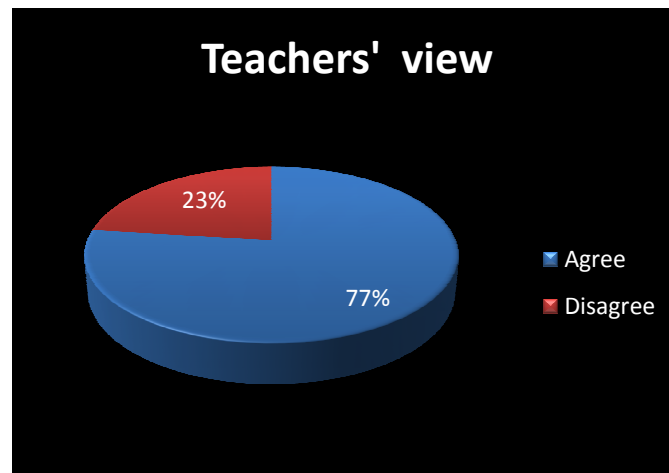

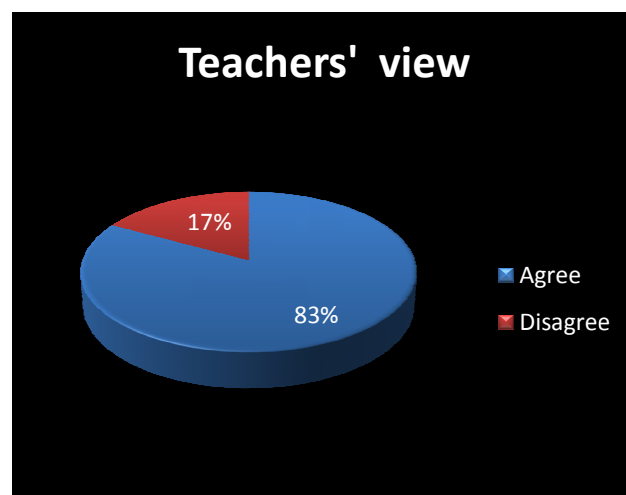

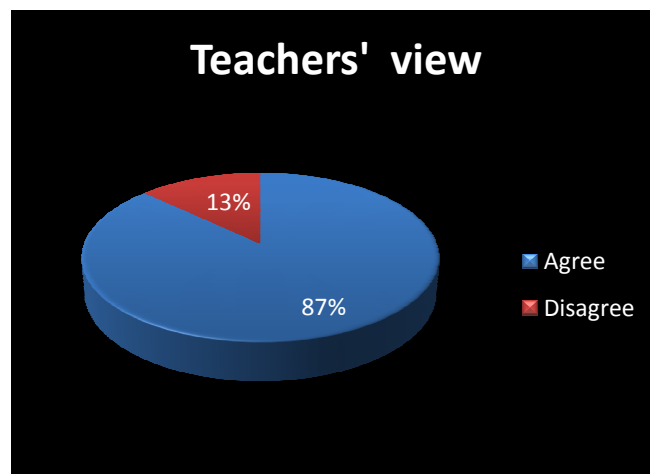

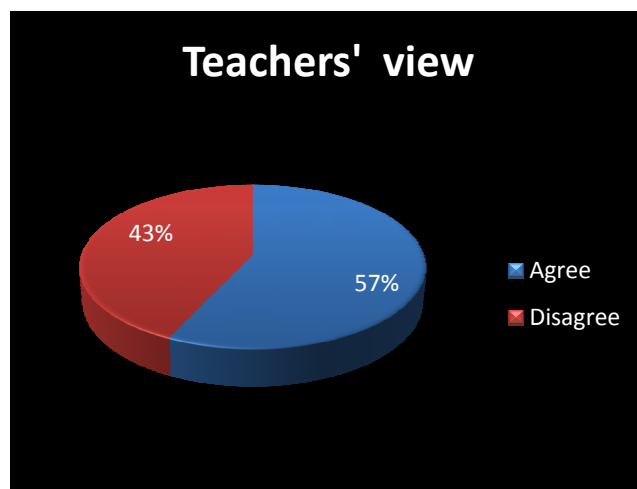

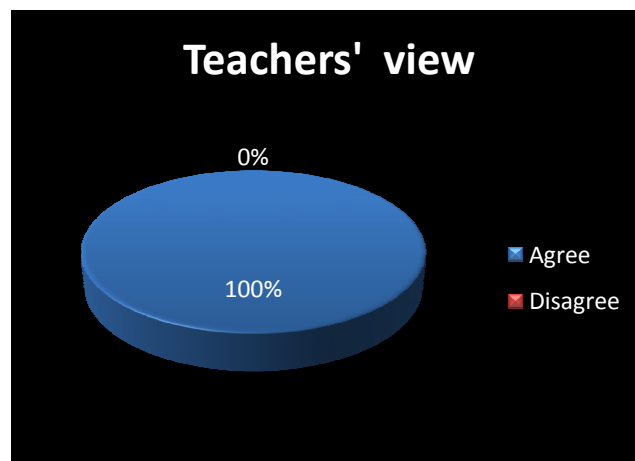

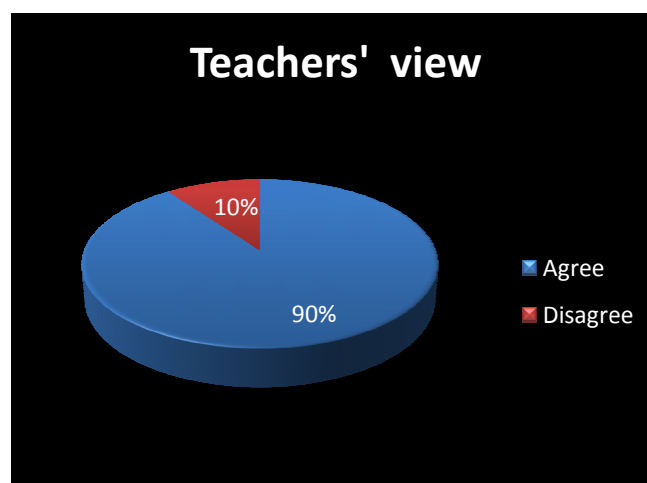

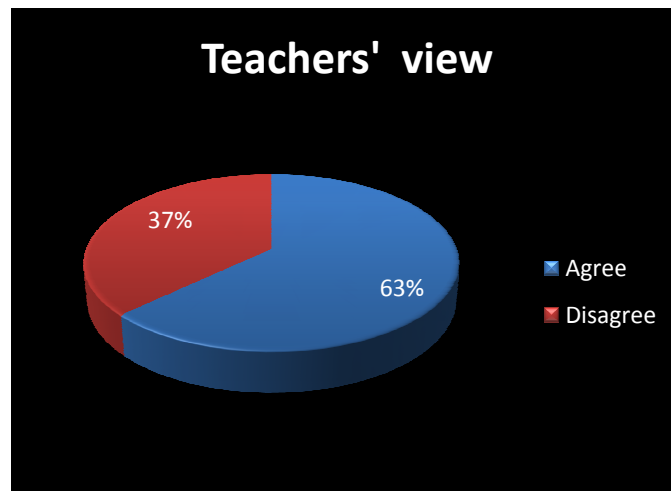

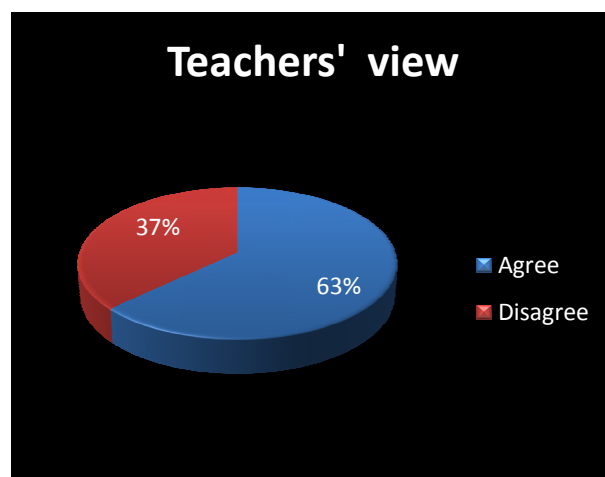

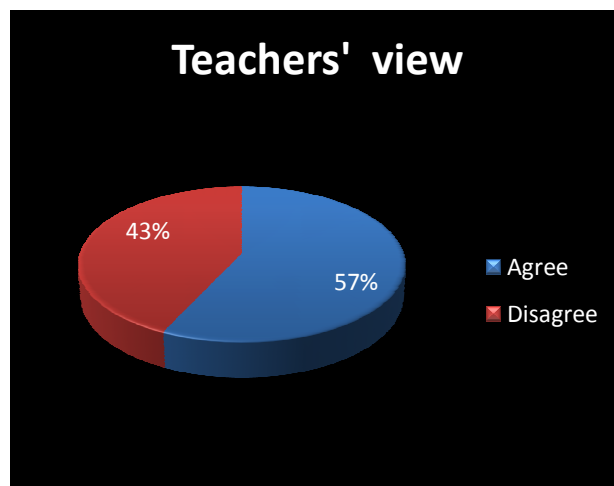

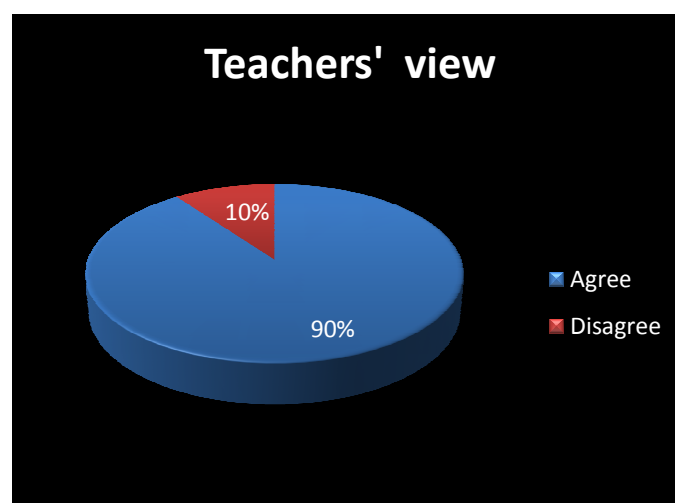

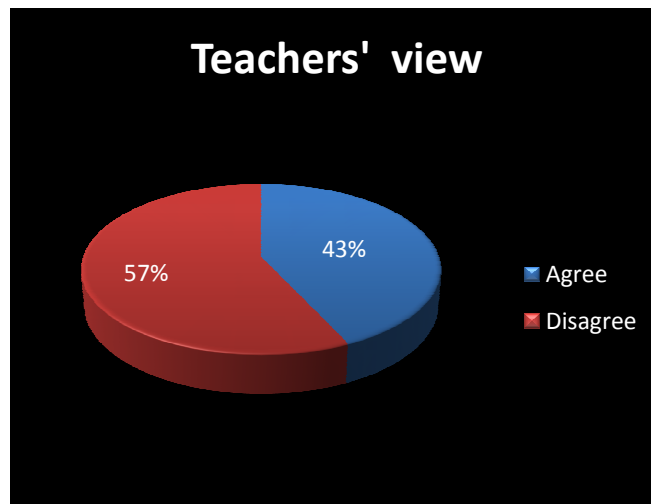

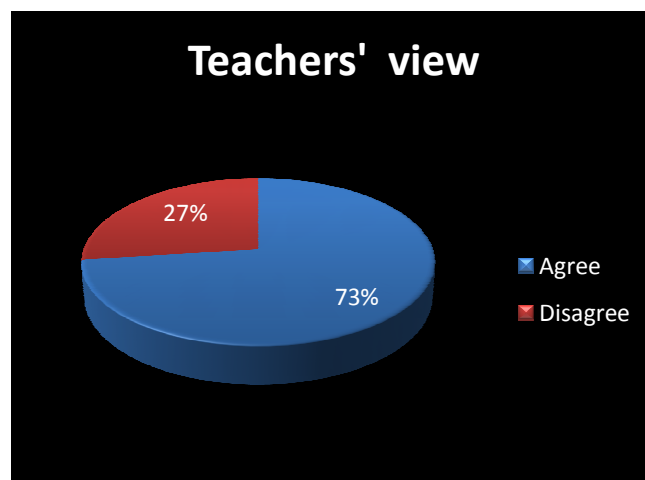
