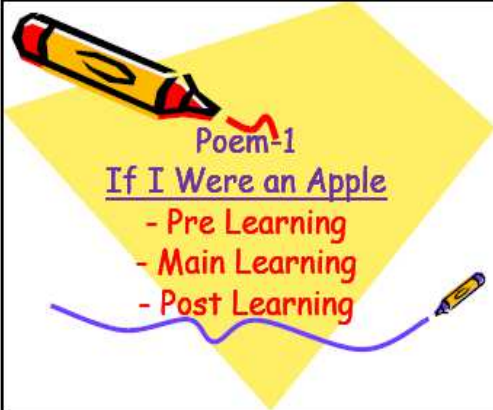

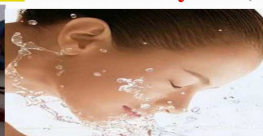

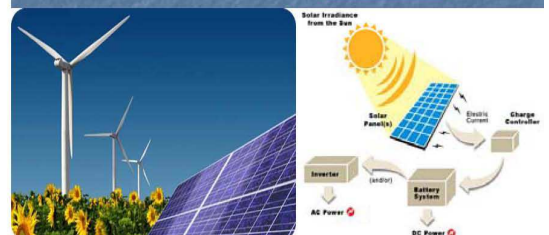

Well, it is the energy from the sun. 'Solar' Means 'from the sun'.



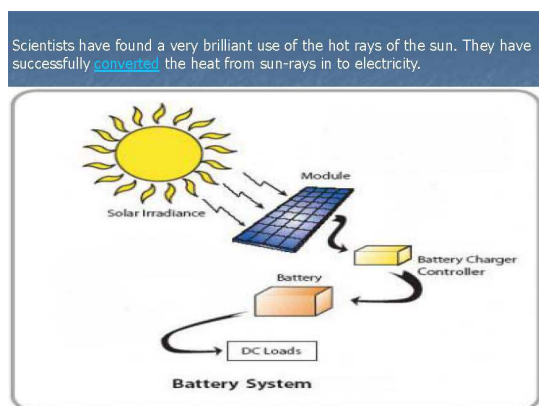
It is a bright star. The earth and other **planets** move around it. This is our **solar system**.
